In 2002, SGM renamed their scholarship in honor of Steve and the qualities he embodied as a person and as an engineer.

Eligibility: The Steve Westhoff Scholarship is available to graduating high school seniors planning to attend a college/university with the intent to pursue studies in civil engineering (such as structural, architectural, traffic/transportation, water, wastewater and environmental engineering), mechanical and electrical engineering, or surveying. **The scholarship is also open to students who have graduated from one of the above-mentioned high schools and are currently attending a college/university and pursuing studies in the above disciplines.** All students are encouraged to reapply yearly. Previous recipients of the Steve Westhoff Scholarship are also eligible. Applications must be submitted by the application deadline to be considered. SGM reserves the right to disqualify applications that are incomplete, late or misrepresentations of the applicant.
